## LYC Baseball Caps for Sale

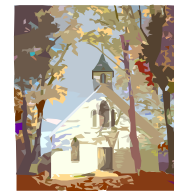
Charlie Wilkerson has a variety of baseball caps in various colors. They are for sale for \$15.00 each.
