ECLAIR CAKE

From Marge Cruse's Kitchen

Cake:

- 1 box graham crackers (1 lb. box)
- 2 boxes (3 1/4 oz) Instant French Vanilla pudding
- 3 1/2 cups milk
- 1 container (8 oz) Cool Whip, thawed

Frosting:

- 1 1/2 cups confectioners sugar
- 1/2 cup cocoa
- 3 tablespoons butter, softened
- 3 tablespoons milk
- 2 teaspoons light corn syrup
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract

Butter the bottom of a 9x13 pan. Line with whole graham crackers. In bowl using an electric mixer, blend pudding with milk; beat at medium speed for 2 min. Fold in Cool Whip. Pour half pudding mixture over graham crackers. Place another layer of whole graham crackers on top of pudding layer. Pour over the remaining half of pudding mixture; top with another layer of graham crackers.

For frosting, blend together sugar and cocoa. Then add butter and milk, mixing well. Add corn syrup and vanilla. Stir until creamy.

Cover cake with frosting and refrigerate for 24 hours. **Enjoy!!!**
