Let the Season Begin!

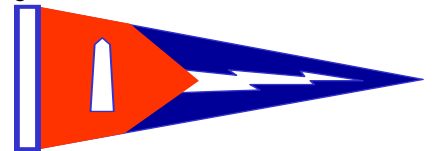
Rear Commodore: Ken Sigler
